Marilyn Mason was born in Oklahoma, began taking piano lessons when under six years of age, and received her first organ lessons from her mother. She was awarded a scholarship at the University of Michigan where she was awarded her Master's Degree.

She studied with the late Palmer Christain, in Paris with Nadia Boulanger and Maurice Daruflé and later with Arnold Schoenberg.

Miss Mason has played on the famous organ of Notre Dame, Paris, and has given recitals in Italy and in this country, including a recital on the organ in Westminster Abbey.

To Miss Mason, the organ is a living instrument, an instrument of our times, and not merely a relic of the past, on which only old masterpieces are performed. She is a contemporary-minded artiste, a scholar of her day, who plays works by living American composers, and to whom works have been dedicated.

Marilyn Mason is already established as one of the outstanding organists of the day, as an artiste who puts music above all else. In her performances, she combines vitality and verve with maturity of experience and insight.

A Member of Faculty at the University of Michigan since 1946, Miss Mason has also taught at Columbia University in New York.
