

LEO SOWERBY

Leo Sowerby stands as America's leading composer of music for the church. He was the first American recipient of the Grande Prix de Rome and holder of a fellowship at the American Academy in Rome. His cantata "Canticle Of The Sun" won the Pulitzer Prize for music in 1946. Dr. Sowerby was for many years head of the Composition Department at the American Conservatory of Music in Chicago. He now heads the College of Church Musicians in Washington, D. C.

MARILYN MASON

Marilyn Mason is Chairman of the Organ Department at the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor. She has been Guest Professor at Columbia University, and also at Union Theological Seminary where she received the Doctor of Sacred Music degree in 1954. Dr. Mason has been heard in recitals throughout North America and Europe. Engagements have included appearances in Westminster Abbey, Vienna, Berlin, Haarlem, Edinburgh, Liverpool, and Stratford-upon-Avon. Because of her interest in contemporary music, she has commissioned numerous composers to write for the organ and has given many premiere performances.
