I holding myself aloof from wrong, from corruption,

“That I will exercise my art solely for the good of my
patients, and will give no drug, perform no operation
for a criminal purpose, even if solicited, far less
suggest it;
“That whatsoever I shall see or hear of the lives of men
which is not fitting to be spoken, I will keep
inviolably secret.
“These things I do promise and in proportion as I am
faithful to this oath may happiness and good
repute be ever mine—the opposite if I shall be
forsworn.”*

PROGRAM NOTE

ALTO RHAPSODY, Op. 53BRAHMS

Few creative artists have put the subject of loneliness into words and music as dramatically as Goethe in his poem, *Harzreise im Winter*, and Brahms in the musical setting he made for that poem, the *Alto Rhapsody*.

The alto soloist asks in the words of the poet "What man is this who stands alone? His trail is lost in the underbrush, behind him the branches of the trees spring together, the grass stands erect where he has passed, and solitude engulfs him. Ah, who can heal the wounds of one to whom balm has become a poison?" The male chorus, held back till now, supports and sets off the alto voice in a prayer of reconciliation. "Is there on your psaltery, All-loving Father, a sound that he can hear? Then reawaken his heart!"
