# marilyn mason

is Professor of Music and Chairman of the Organ Department at the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor. She received her Doctor of Sacred Music degree from Union Theological Seminary. Dr. Mason has made concert appearances around the world. During the 1970-1971 season, she played on five continents: North America (New York, Los Angeles, Washington, D. C. ), South America, Europe (Paris, France and Oxford, England), Africa (Cairo), and Australia. She was the first American woman to play in Westminster Abbey. She is particularly interested in contemporary music and has commissioned numerous composers to write for the organ. In 1971, Dr. Mason dedicated the Schantz organ here at First Baptist Church.
