Marilyn Mason, University Organist and Chairman of the Organ Department at the University of Michigan, will be featured in an Organ Workshop, "Performance Problems in Organ Music," on March 26 and an Organ Concert on Sunday, March 27, at Glen Leven Presbyterian Church. Having served the University for nearly 30 years, she was a pupil of Palmer Christian in her Michigan student days and also studied with Nadia Boulanger and Maurice Durufle. She attended Union Theological Seminary where she earned the degree of Doctor of Sacred Music. She was the first American woman to play in Westminster Abbey, the first woman organist to play in Latin America, and the first American organist to play in Egypt. Numerous invitations have taken her to five continents: North and South America, Europe, Africa and Australia. She has served as adjudicator at almost every major competition in the world; her own repertoire is immense, covering every period of literature. Her performances are noted for their "vitality, great sweep and kaleidoscopic registration." Her artistic achievements distinguish her as not only a recitalist and teacher, but also as a judge and recording artist. In further contribution to her profession she has commissioned over 30 works by contemporary American composers, each dedicated to her and premiered by her.
