THE ORGAN

The Gress-Miles Pipe Organ was designed especially for Grace Lutheran Church, and reflects the most advanced thought in contemporary organ building. The total versatility of the instrument enables the music to be presented as the composers intended, whether classic, romantic or contemporary. It will function in the tradition of the Schnitger and Silbermann organs which inspired the works of Buxtehude and Bach, in the nineteenth century style familiar to Liszt or Reger, or equally well in accompanying the services and for music of our own day. Each division has been given its distinctive location in the case-work, which serves to focus the sound in the classic manner, and all the facade pipes speak. Expression shutters are provided for the swell division. The organ has 2 manuels 26 ranks, and 1,492 pipes. Mr. and Mrs. Edward Knabusch, charter members of Grace Lutheran Church, donated the organ to Grace in the year 1970.
