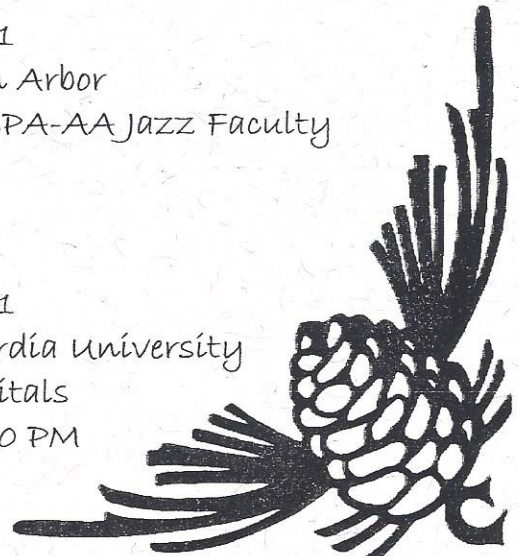

About today's soloists ...

Marilyn Mason is University Organist and Professor of Music at the University of Michigan. Her extensive career as concert organist, lecturer, adjudicator, and educator has carried her throughout the musical world. Her discography includes music of Bach, Pachelbel, Handel and contemporary composers on Columbia and Musical Heritage Society labels.

Dean Baxtresser began playing the oboe in sixth grade, and in seventh grade played under Dan Long at Slauson Middle School. He has studied with Kristin Reynolds, Kristen Beene, and Dan Stoper. During his year and a half with the Youth Symphony he participated at the Midwest Clinic in Chicago. He has spent the past two summers at Interlochen Center for the Arts, and is currently studying with Dr. Nancy Ambrose-King at the University of Michigan. He is in the eleventh grade at Pioneer High School and hopes to major in music in college.

Gwendolyn Kantor started her flute studies at the age of 7. She has studied with Jeff Zook of the Detroit Symphony, and is currently working with Dawn Kullak. During her five years with the Youth Symphony she had the privilege of playing in Australia and the Midwest clinic in Chicago. In October of this year she won first place at the High School solo wind division in Ithaca College, New York. Ms. Kantor is a senior at Pioneer High School where she is a member of the Symphony Orchestra and Symphony Band. She was recently named a winner of the Pioneer High School Concerto Competition. In addition, she is principal flute of the Michigan Youth Orchestra. Gwendolyn hopes to attend Ithaca College and major in Music Performance.
