**Marilyn Mason** is University Organist and Chairman of the Organ Department of the University of Michigan, which recently celebrated her 60<sup>th</sup> year on the faculty, a first in its history. Her extensive career as concert organist, lecturer, adjudicator and teacher has carried her throughout the world. The first American woman to play in Westminster Abbey and the Vatican, she has served as judge at nearly every major organ competition in the world, and has lectured and performed at all the major organ and church music conferences in North America. She was awarded an honorary Doctor of Music degree from the University of Nebraska in 1987, and was named "1988 Performer of the Year" by the New York Chapter of the American Guild of Organists. Committed to showcasing contemporary composers, she has personally commissioned and premiered 70 contemporary organ compositions. Dr. Mason also leads European organ tours; professionals, amateurs and tag-a-longs are invited to sign up for her 55<sup>th</sup> such trip in summer 2008.
